BLS 2.0 has 11 student leaders enrolled, and will focus on servant leadership.

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#### **Study Abroad Leadership Debrief**

The Margo F. Souza Student Leadership Center partnered with the Office of International Affairs at UC Merced for the first ever Study Abroad Leadership Debrief. During this program, students who had recently returned from studying abroad were provided the opportunity to discuss the various ways their experience abroad impacted their leadership development.

The students who participated in the Study Abroad Leadership Debrief had just returned from Study Abroad programs in various countries, including South Africa, Spain, New Zealand, and South Korea. During the debrief, the students explored a list of 21st Century Leadership Skills. The students shared that this was the first time they were able to discuss how their experience abroad has influenced their leadership development.

#### Student Success Internship Program

The Margo F. Souza Student Leadership Center is excited to announce that center will be welcoming a Success Success Intern for the 2019-2020 academic year! The Equity in Leadership Student Success internship serves as a unique opportunity to address the racial disparities in leadership development that are often overlooked by most leadership programs.

The Equity in Leadership Intern will have the opportunity to research the intersection of Critical Race Theory and Leadership Development, and apply their research to develop a compilation of leadership development resources (both original & pre-existing) for UC Merced students and local youth-facing nonprofit organizations.

The Student Success Intern will play a large role in assisting the Margo F. Souza Student Leadership Center in fulfilling its goal to "create the future through the eyes of our students," as Margo F. Souza once so-beautifully articulated in the creation of the center.

This project aligns with the UC Merced Division of Student Affairs Strategic Initiatives that aim to increase equity and access for student success. The project will also provide a much-needed resource for our diverse population of student leaders, as well as the overall Merced County community.
